Due Date, Contents



Final Report

- Due Date: April 12th
 - A week from this Thursday
 - Due at 5pm, penalty 10% for each hour late.

Maximum 2000 words

- Docked 5% of final report grade for every 10 words over 2000, or proportionate therein
- Report must include word count in document
- Minimum font size 12 points
- Pictures & words in pictures not counted
- 500 extra words for groups with Appers (i.e. total 2500)



Final Report Content

- 1. Introduction
 - What & Why
- 2. Overall Design
 - Block diagram, description of each part
- 3. Statement of Functionality & Screen Shots from App
 - Did it work? Describe & show parts that worked
 - For parts that did not work, describe & speculate as to why
- 4. What did you learn what would you do differently?



Final Report Content

5. Contribution by Group Members

- Describe what each group member did in project
- Use to create individual grade

6. For Apper Projects only: Apper Context

- 500 words, separate from main word count
- Describe how what was achieved can influence your research field, or the field of application.
- Must be written by the Apper only

7. Future Work

- How could the app be augmented to make it better?
- Suggest additional features and capabilities
- 8. Say if you be interested in having a Business School class on marketing/entrepreneurship take it up?
